- 2. Bruce Ewart, Middle School liaison, attended the November Executive Board meeting to discuss issues surrounding middle school athletics. Bruce will obtain a current email list of all athletic directors. Elaine suggested once the schedules are complete they be mailed to the AD of each school. A suggestion was made to have all middle school Sport Directors' names and email addresses be placed on the middle school website. Schedules should be posted on line. The problem exists because there is no one to do all the work necessary for the website. Students from Charter Schools will be allowed to participate for their home school in the future.
- 3. Cox Sports Awards- will be discussed at the breakfast. There are concerns about the voting system.
- 4. The RIIL will conduct a mandatory clinic in January for baseball coaches and players to discuss new NFHS rule changes.
- 5. Please return your nomination forms for our association Awards Banquet. The deadline is Dec 10th. The banquet will be Wednesday April 8th at Rhodes on the Pawtuxet.
- 6. Discussions by the RIIL are underway for the next realignment. A timeline has been established for an announcement of the realignment for September 2009.
