- 2. Tom Mezzanotte reports there will be no increase in official's fees for the next two years. The dues and fees from the RIIL will not increase with the possible exception of hockey.
- 3. Tom is also looking for football coaches' input on putting five game officials on the field rather than one being the game clock operator.
- 4. Sport Committee chairpersons will be asked to give a report at the March general meeting at the Cape. There are still issues about rules being passed without the AD serving on the sport committee being contacted.
- 5. Bob Palazzo has created a model that all coaches associations can adopt. It allows for documentation of dues and fees. With this information the associations can apply for a tax ID number. Cross-country, indoor and outdoor track are now under one umbrella.
- 6. New rule for baseball and softball pitchers and catchers needs clarification.
- 7. RIIAAA Constitution/By-Laws have been revised and will be voted upon at the March general meeting.
