The following important information, which has come out of discussions from our recent meeting, is to help keep you aware of current issues or concerns in Rhode Island athletics.

- 1. There is a mandatory pre-winter sports meeting for Athletic Directors scheduled for November 7, 2012, 8pm. Location is TBD. A general meeting of the RIIAAA will take place after the RIIL meeting.
- 2. Due to the EEE virus, the Board of Health recommends to change games to the afternoon (per dusk); and the RIIL has given a uniform exemption so athletes may wear long sleeves and leggings under uniforms. Several schools have taken this into consideration. They also continue to assess the EEE virus issue on a week by week basis.
- 3. John Abbate will replace Beth Penkala, retired AD on the RIIL Hall of Fame Committee.
- 4. RIIL Hall of Fame deadline is November 1, 2012. If you have a potential candidate for the 2013 Class of the RIIL Hall of Fame, send in their completed application by the November deadline. November 17, 2012 is the meeting date for the selection committee.
