- 1. The Athletic Director's mandatory meeting has been set for Wednesday, August 15, 2012 site TBD. The New Principals and Athletic Directors' meeting is Thursday, August 23, 2012.
- 2. Sports Committees will be posted on both the RIIAAA and RIIL website for coaches reference.
- 3. A realignment subcommittee will be formed to include Tom Marcello and at least two other RIAAA members. The purpose of the subcommittee is to maintain records by sport.
- 4. All fall sports realignments for 2012-2014 have been accepted as presented to the PCOA.
- 5. The RIIAAA representative to the PCOA for 2012-2014 is Mike Traficante.
- 6. Please pay attention to the recently sent out information on the Football and Field Hockey goalie heat index formula. It is strongly suggested that schools implement the heat index formula as early as August 2012.
- 7. Coaches' Associations and JV scheduling is still being investigated. One main concern is the accountability of coaches' association fees by sport. The JV concern is relative to the need for advanced scheduling and tournament information.
- 8. A new LTC 620 Proper Fitting of Equipment will be offered December 2012.
