The following important information, which has come out of discussions from our recent meeting, is to help keep you aware of current issues or concerns in Rhode Island athletics.

1) Committee Reports:

Girls Soccer

-preliminary divisions, finalizing schedule for March meeting.

-Playoff eligibility (similar to boys)-Will be discussed at the next meeting.

Golf

-survey out to course superintendents to get feedback about a possible switch to fall

Indoor Track

-Schedule worked out well.

-Stance of coaches' association is that they don't want pole vaulting at indoor as a scoring event.

-RIIAAA is exploring the possibility of the scoring of pole vault.

Hockey

- Girls hockey finals are the same weekend of the USA regionals.

-Working through this scheduling conflict.

-RIIL: if coaches agree, there is not a problem moving the state finals (might not be at a big venue)

Baseball

-Division 1 and Division 2 championships will be played at McCoy.

-PawSox looking to offer Saturday workouts on McCoy for high school teams.

Boys' Basketball

-playoffs on schedule

Volleyball

-Girls division 1 coaches unhappy with the realignment (per coaches' association).

-Not happy with the not playing teams twice.

-Realignment is going forward.

Boys' Soccer

-only movement in realignment EWG moving down to Division 3, and Cranston West is moving up to Division 2

Boys' and Girls' Swim

-looking for approval to split up the boys and girls for division meets

Girls' Basketball

-Division 1 wants to go to 16 teams, but committee is comfortable with 10 teams. -discussion about changing the power points for the open tournament.

Softball

-Coaches association (\$10 coaches' dues, no banquet fee, optional \$50 for booklet ads)

Football

-Committee chose 14 team Division 1, Division 2, and Division 3 (coaches didn't want an 8-team D1)

-Some discussion of teams wanting to move down.

-discussion about the importance of full-time athletic trainers
